RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations have been established for the protection and benefit of **all** members of Club Brennan and their guests. They have been established to ensure the safe and hygienic operations of the Club and its facilities. All people named on a membership application/registration form are the responsibility of the *holder* of said membership. All guests of a member are the responsibility of said member.

The Pool Manager has full authority to interpret all rules and regulations of the Club.

The Pool Manager and all staff are responsible for enforcing these rules.

Failure to comply with these rules is considered cause for suspension from the pool. Any member in violation of these rules/regulations or the Bylaws which govern Club Brennan, is at risk of expulsion from the Club and revocation of membership. [Article VIII, Section 8]

The penalties for rule infractions will be:

1st Offense: Verbal warning

2nd Offense: Sit out for 10 minutes

3rd Offense: Out of the DAY

4th Offense: Suspension

These rules are guidelines for the lifeguard. They have the authority to remove any member or guest for up to 1(one) week.

Removal for longer than one week will be at the Board's discretion.

The following activities are prohibited:

*Flips

*Back Dives

*Spin Jumps

*Running

*Jumping

*Fighting

*Dunking

*Chicken fights (or any rough play)

*Spitting

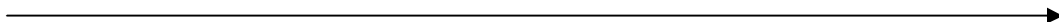
*Foul Language

*Hanging on lane lines or ropes

SECTION 1 – GROUND RULES

- No one is admitted without a Pool Pass or Guest Pass.
- Pool Passes are *assigned* to members. Unauthorized use is strictly prohibited; you risk loss of membership.
- Private parties may be held at the discretion of the Manager; all guests of parties are the responsibility of the member hosting the party; parties are held between specific hours and all guests must leave the party at the end of the specified time or member will be charged an additional hour.
- Alcoholic beverages are **strictly prohibited**. Public Drunkenness is against the law; police will be called if it is noted by members or staff.
- No unauthorized people are permitted in the office at any time.
- No loitering will be allowed at the entry way, check-in desk, or office.
- No loitering near lifeguard stands; the distraction of lifeguards can be hazardous.

SECTION 2 – POOL RULES

- Obey and respect the Lifeguards. They are the Authorities and are here for our safety.
- A shower must be taken before entering the pool to ensure proper hygiene.
- Proper swimming attire is required. Cut-off shorts and t-shirts are not permitted.
- Toys are allowed in the pool at the lifeguard's discretion. Please ask first.
- Children who are not toilet-trained must wear a swim diaper *at all times*. Staff reserves the right to ask/check before young member's use of facility.
- Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or childcare provider over the age of 18 years.
- Swimming in the deep-end is allowed after you have passed the "deep water test" administered by the lifeguards. This rule applies to everyone under 12 years old.
- No diving (head first) in any area of pool.
- Lap lanes are for adults (18 years & older); and are for lap swimming only.
- Diving blocks are off-limits at all times.
- All Guests must have an adult member present at **ALL** times.*
 - *Bondholder teens, age 15 and up, may bring up to 2 guests, age 14 and up. Staff reserves the right to withdraw this privilege upon abuse of it.
- Physical/verbal altercations are prohibited and warrant calling the police.
- Foul language is prohibited.
